With interest - accompanied by a curious spiritual search for a new message, an "other testament" of places and ideas - I opened and read the essay of my good friend Paul Pissanos entitled: "THE GREAT TESTAMENT".

I must admit that I am very skeptical about every new edition in the flood of the publishing market today, which usually obscures the top problems and dilemmas of our time that do not illuminate, that pollute with natural paper the natural and man-made environment that is threatened.

As I read the essay, my skepticism receded to give way to surprise and satisfaction from listing well-known positions and principles that must be set today, every day, as the basis of a proper reflection, individual and collective.

The ideas presented by the chosen friend in a deeply human, simple and responsible way and therefore convincing are not new and shocking. New and really moving is the reminder, the attitude - the "memory" Plato wanted, we put it here symbolically - principles and values that we often forget in the daily vortex and Heavy confusion of purposes and means of the modern technocratic - breathless in many aspects production and consumption culture.

These values and principles that are the foundations of the true history of Man and of the Spiritual Civilization are the foundations of the great moral covenant, the wisdom of thought of the Eastern Peoples and Religions of the Old Testament, of Greek Philosophy, of the Gospel of Christianity, of the creation of the European Spirit from the Renaissance until today, reminds us all and brings before us the author.

CHAPTER I

ABOUT LEARNING

HERMES:

I find it strange, teacher, that you can, at the age that you are, live and understand the problems of today's world. How is it possible for my generation to be known to you with its qualifications, its strengths and weaknesses, its right and wrong. I see your eyes closed in front of the spectacles of a humanity that goes to the stars and your ears are unable to hear the news and events that happen every minute on the planet we live on. I believe that your opinion, no matter how beautiful, will be far from the reality of today. But, whatever you say, I will listen to it with respect.

ANONYMOUS: You are right to believe, my good child, that I, who am old, am far from the reality of the world of your age. And you are right, because you are exactly young. The cradle of knowledge is experience. "But the experience is gained with the time when the events take place and not just with the perception. Do you think that my eyes are closed, unable to see the miracles of today's man?

My ears are also helpless to hear the news of "now"? And yet, my dear Hermes, the panorama of the modern world is alive in front of me. And this happens, because human thought is larger than the size of this Earth and comfortably fits its images and wonders, its joys and sorrows.

HERMES:

So tell me, how do you "see" with your own eyes new generations of children, how do you "hear" with your own ears the sounds and misery of today's world? And how do you think the people of the future will pass through the gates of knowledge, to enter the light of the city of your dreams?

ANONYMOUS: First of all, my dear Hermes, I would like to explain to you what youth is. I would like you to realize, at the age of sixteen that you are, what period of your life you are going through and what messages your thought must assimilate, in order to take a responsible position in the destinies of your life.

> Youth is the context through which experience is gained. Youth is a part of the time of our life, during which man studies himself and his scale within the total size of the surrounding world. You are young and now you open your eyes to the glittering flashes of life.

> Behind your perception the ages around you remain constant and you believe that the young and the middle-aged and the old as they are were born and as they are will remain. Do you still believe that the trees, the houses, the roads, everything around you was born that way, it has always been that way, and it will always be that way. The concept of evolution is assimilated into human perception at the onset of adolescence. Until the end of adolescence, my dearest young man, my mind is dominated by static perception. And I say this because static perception binds thought and does not allow it to easily enter into the essence of phenomena that represent the truth of positive or negative reality.

Through the eyes of your youth life is reflected by the glow that the images of your personal life have.

If you are young, poor, illiterate and despised and the images in the symbols of the world and your environment are adapted to your experiences, you see it all in sorrow. If, on the other hand, you are young, the offspring of a wealthy family with a multitude of material goods, You see everything brightly. You cannot realize that no matter how much it seems in the environment of your life that misery gives a separate result from what you calculate.

That happiness has a different aspect from pleasures. That pleasures always result in the decay of the flesh and the soul.

And all this happens, because, as a young person, you are a prisoner of your static perception.

And if you realize that youth entails unreadiness, that you did not complete the wings of your thought to fly to the horizon of knowledge, you will realize that you see everything from the position you are in and not in the position which is. The greatest gift to young people is to assimilate the instructions of adults.

The young man who has the power to channel the vitality of his action through the channels of advice of his elders, is the one who makes the fewest mistakes.

The young man, who can follow the paths of the right guidance, is the one who will one day be able to have others follow him. Because the best follower was always the best leader. My dear Hermes, with the static perception of your age, you see me as an eternal old man, without vision and without good hearing. And even though you know it, you still can't realize that I was once young, younger than you and like you.

I am the grand scale within which yours fits.

I am your "I", which will soon become like mine, so that you have complete thought, intellect and judgment. And I emphasize this to you, so that you and all the young people of the Earth may know that the realization of your scale in the size of the thinking of the adults is nothing but the right line that leads to the right goal of the right choice.

HERMES:

I feel what I hear from your mouth, teacher, making one big change in my thoughts. It is a great good that you fill my soul with your words. I would ask you to help me understand the goals and choices of my life.

ANONYMOUS: What I will say to you, my dear Hermes, concerns all the young people of the world who are close to your age. Approaching the end of the first phase of your apprenticeship, you are presented with a set of options and goals for defining your future life.

> And, certainly, before defining your goals and choices, you must first realize who you are, why you exist and where you are going! Because the solutions you will give to these questions will determine your ethics, which is the Pedestal of support for your goals and choices. You must fully understand and believe that the Universe exists and lives within a supreme ethos. The Harmony.

> Everything moves in an eternal moral cycle, which is moral, so that there is no self-destruction. If in the Universe the phenomena did not obey the divine law, the planets and the Aether and the nebulae in the celestial sphere would not exist, because one would destroy the other. Does the Universe declare, in its eternal harmony, its absolute submission to the supreme moral law?... that, whatever is good for the whole is also good for the unit. If one by one people think that the good of the whole is in their own good, humanity will change its face.

How can there be spiritual progress in a place when the people of that place are chasing vanity, riches and pleasures based on selfishness and self-interest? And if you, my dear Hermes, come at some point and stand upright in front of the vision of your future career, your goals and your choices, will you think about how useful you should be for society as a whole or only how much will you benefit yourself? Will the motivations that will guide the criteria of your choices start from your personal service or from the common good? Will you follow the profession that you have talent to do and that will be beneficial for everyone, or the profession that you were informed in the course of your life that it is the most profitable?

Will you unite your life with the woman you truly loved and entered into your soul, or will you seek marriage with a wealthy husband, to reap the money of your vanity?

Will you have friends who have prudence, justice and humility, or big and loud followers of the night, of easy riches and wickedness? Will you stand by your elderly parents with parsimony, love and self-denial, or will you deprive those who gave birth to you of your presence and your tenderness, because you will be drowned in your work and occupations?

Will you do justice, even if you are harmed, or will you ignore every moral law in the face of profit?

HERMES:

I feel the mechanism of my consciousness being moved. I am looking for solutions to the big questions you ask on my behalf. I would ask you to help me with your judgment, because I want to reach the right thought for my professional orientation. At my age it concerns me very seriously.

ANONYMOUS: I must, first of all, emphasize to you, my dear Hermes, that your choice for the job you will do in the future has two different directions, because the meanings of each direction are also different.

When you do a job for the sole purpose of getting rich, it is referred to as a "profession". When you do a job that responds to your sensibilities, your talent and serves the common good, this is referred to as a "function". If in the modern world young people, in general, decide to enter life as ministers and not as professionals, to cover the public and private sectors, the technical and artistic professions and in terms of human functionality in its mechanism society, this society will change its form!

Ethical relations in human transactions within the professions have been abolished and ridiculed, precisely because people act as professionals and not as functionaries. And if today the order and function in the placement of human factors in all the activities of private and public life has been lost, it is because the professional positions are filled by irresponsible or incompetent or opportunistic individuals, who were found to be fill the positions, for the sole purpose of monetary gain.

In a proper social structure, the people - operators will be at the same time the excellent professionals. Because, if the purpose of an official is to perform his work for the common good, the result as a whole will be for him to win along with everyone! If, on the other hand, the professional occupies a position with some maneuvering or the help of a third party, without his psychosynthesis and talent matching the type of work he does but with the sole aim of getting rich, the result in social upwardness is disastrous.
